

END-USER LICENSE AGREEMENT (EULA)

Last Updated: April 4th, 2026

1. Purpose and Relationship with Terms

This End-User License Agreement (“EULA”) governs the licensing and permitted use of the PartsCollab platform and related software, systems, and digital infrastructure (the “Platform”) provided by SkyReady Teknoloji ve Danışmanlık A.Ş. (“SkyReady”).

This EULA forms an integral and complementary part of the SkyReady Terms of Service. In the event of any conflict:

- (i) the Disclaimer and Limitation of Liability Statement shall govern all matters relating to liability and risk allocation;
- (ii) this EULA shall govern all matters relating to licensing and permitted use of the Platform; and
- (iii) the Terms of Service shall govern all other matters unless expressly stated otherwise.

2. License Grant

Subject to compliance with the Terms of Service and this EULA, SkyReady grants the User a:

- limited,
- non-exclusive,
- non-transferable,
- non-sublicensable

license to access and use the Platform solely for its intended business purposes.

This license does not grant any ownership rights in the Platform.

3. Ownership of the Platform

All rights, title, and interest in and to the Platform, including but not limited to:

- software, source code, and object code,
- system architecture and infrastructure,
- algorithms and data models,
- interfaces, designs, and user experience,
- trademarks, logos, and brand elements,

are and shall remain the exclusive property of SkyReady or its licensors.

No rights are granted except as expressly set forth in this EULA.

4. Permitted Use

The User may use the Platform solely:

- within the scope of its subscription or authorized access,
- for legitimate commercial and operational purposes,
- in compliance with applicable laws and regulations.

The User shall not use the Platform in any manner that exceeds the scope of the granted license.

5. Restrictions

The User shall not, directly or indirectly:

- copy, reproduce, distribute, or commercially exploit the Platform,
- reverse engineer, decompile, disassemble, or attempt to derive the source code,
- create derivative works based on the Platform,
- use automated systems (including bots, scrapers, or crawlers) to extract data,
- bypass or interfere with security measures or system integrity,
- use the Platform to build or support a competing product or service,
- provide unauthorized third-party access to the Platform.

Any use outside the scope of this license is strictly prohibited.

6. User Accounts and Access

The User is responsible for:

- maintaining the confidentiality of account credentials,
- all activities conducted under its account,
- ensuring that authorized users comply with this EULA.

SkyReady shall not be liable for unauthorized access resulting from the User's failure to safeguard credentials.

7. Suspension and Termination of License

SkyReady may suspend or terminate the User's license and access to the Platform if:

- the User breaches this EULA or the Terms of Service,
- the Platform is used unlawfully or abusively,
- system integrity or security is compromised.

Upon termination, the User's right to use the Platform ceases immediately.

8. No Implied Rights

No rights or licenses are granted by implication, estoppel, or otherwise, except as expressly stated in this EULA.

All rights not expressly granted are reserved by SkyReady.

9. Data and Content

This EULA does not regulate ownership of data.

All data ownership, processing, and usage rights are governed by the Intellectual Property and Data Ownership Statement and the Privacy Policy.

10. Platform Nature and Liability Reference

This EULA governs only the licensing of the Platform.

All matters related to:

- liability limitations,
- disclaimers,
- user-to-user transactions,
- aviation compliance responsibilities

are governed exclusively by the

Disclaimer and Limitation of Liability Statement and the Terms of Service.

SkyReady reserves the right to modify this EULA at any time.

Updated versions shall become effective upon publication on the Platform.
